Personal attire and belongings:

- Children are expected to bring only the required number of clothes as mentioned in the clothing and accessories list.
- To maintain personal hygiene, and also given the public health situation, the exchange of personal items among students is strictly prohibited.
- Students will use and take care of their personal belongings and keep them clean and hygienic.
- We expect the students to label their clothes and personal accessories.

Dress Code:

- Children are not permitted to wear short shirts/T-shirts/tops, Tight skirts, short dresses, or low-waist jeans/trousers even on special occasions.
- Tight-fitting clothes, sleeveless and clothes made of thin, see-through material are not permitted.
- Any form of writing on clothes, prominent brand names, logos or statements must be strictly avoided. Plain clothing, without any form of print, is preferred and recommended.
- Girls in classes 3 to 6 are allowed to wear knee-length frocks and skirts to school. And boys in classes 3-6 are allowed to wear shorts to school.
- Boys and girls are allowed to wear round-necked T-shirts with formal pants, trousers, or jeans on Saturdays and during the evening prep time.
- Children are allowed to wear casual clothes on Sundays (round-necked T-shirts, loose track pants, knee-length trousers, long skirts)

Personal accessories:

- Children do not need perfume, deodorants, cologne, hair gel, hair cream, cosmetics, jewellery and other similar articles. Please ensure that they do not bring them to school. The school is equipped with a tuck shop that provides toiletry and stationery.
- The use of nail polish and kajal (collyrium) or any other kind of eye or face colouring or pieces of jewellery is not permitted.
- Multiple piercings on ears are discouraged.
- Expensive, branded wristwatches and footwear should be avoided in school.
- High heels of any kind are not permitted.
